This matter came on regularly before the Honorable Stanley Weisberg, judge presiding, in Department D of the Superior Court, Van Nuys Courthouse East. After review of all papers, argument and evidence, the Court finds and orders as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. Plaintiff JNS Copy Service, Inc. is awarded judgment against defendant Optima Funding, Inc. and defendant Ali Shah, individually and severally, each and all, in the amount of \$ 192,000; for prejudgment interest at the rate of 10% in the total amount of \$ 24,944; (on \$ 192,000 from January 1, 2005 ^{the date of the most recent fax}); and for attorney's fees and costs in the amount of \$ 182,162. **TOTAL:** \$ 399,106. The clerk shall enter this judgment forthwith.

2. The Court issues an Order for Permanent Injunction as to defendants Optima


1 Funding, Inc. and Ali Shah, as of this date.

4 were "willful" and "knowing" within the meaning of that Act.


5 4. The Court finds by clear and convincing evidence that the conduct of each of
6 these two defendants Optima Funding, Inc. and Ali Shah, was knowing, oppressive and
7 malicious, was in conscious disregard of the Plaintiff's rights, and caused willful and
8 malicious injury to the Plaintiff and its property.
